**Athletics
Rules & Regulations**

1. LAWS OF THE GAME

The Championships shall be held in accordance with the existing rules and regulations of the International Association of Athletics Federation (IAAF) and conducted mainly by Malaysia Amateur Athletic Association (MAAA).

2. PLAYER ELIGIBILITY

All athletes participating in this competition must be full-time students or staff (team managers) of their respective universities. Students are reminded to bring along matriculation cards or any other form of identification which certify their eligibility. **Failure to do so would disqualify the play.**

3. REPRESENTATION

- a. Each institution may register a maximum of **2** competitors for each individual events and **1** team for each relay.
- b. Each institution may register a maximum of **30** athletes, regardless men or women, **2** coaches and **1** official for both Men and Women teams.
- c. Each athlete only allowed to register for no more than 3 individual events, regardless track or field event.
- d. Should there be more than 8 entries for events run in lanes, heats shall be conducted. The 8 fastest competitors shall qualify for the finals.
- e. Any event with less than 3 registered participants will be cancelled.

6. POINTS

All competitors shall be awarded **1** league point for participation for each event. **2** points shall be awarded for participation in each team event.

7. DRAW FOR LANES/ORDERS OF TRIALS

- The draw for lanes/order of trials for all events shall be held before the program is printed
- The lanes for finals will be drawn based on timing in the order as follows:
 - the best 4 competitors for lanes 4, 5, 3 and 6.
 - the slower 4 competitors for lanes 2, 7, 1 and 8.

8. TIES

If two or more teams tie on points in the overall score, the Championships (men's, women's) shall be awarded to the team which wins:

- more first placings in the corresponding categories.

9. FIELD EVENTS

Competitors shall take their trials in the order indicated in the program unless the Referee decides to alter that order. All competitors shall be given 3 trials and the best 8 competitors another 3 attempts.

10. PROTEST OR APPEAL AGAINST RESULTS

- Any protest must be submitted to the Referee in writing by the Team Manager together with a deposit of **USD75** and within 30 minutes after the results have been announced for the respective event.

- If the protest is rejected, the deposit shall be forfeited. If the protest is upheld, the deposit shall be returned.
