**Chess
Rules & Regulations**

1. LAWS OF THE GAME

The competition shall be governed by these Rules and shall be played in accordance with the Federation Internationale Des Echecs (FIDE) Laws of the Game and regulations of Biennial Intersvarsity Games (BIG).

2. PLAYER ELIGIBILITY

All players participating in this competition must be full-time students or staff (team managers) of their respective universities. Students are reminded to bring along matriculation cards or any other form of identification which certify their eligibility. **Failure to do so would disqualify the play.**

3. REPRESENTATION

- (a) Each team may be represented by a **maximum of 8 players (4 Men and 4 Women)**.
- (b) Each institute can register a maximum of **1** coach and **1** official.
- (c) Teams must be represented by a team manager or official from the Institution concerned during the course of a match.

4. COMPETITION RULES

4.1 System of Play

- (a) The competition is conducted in Round Robin format.
- (b) The number of rounds will depend on the number of participants.

4.2 Duration of Game

- (a) The game is 90 minutes and 30 seconds extra for each movement for each player.
- (b) The time control for each game is made using a chess clock.

4.3 Record of Game

Each player is required to record every movement made.

4.4 Ranking of Entries

- (a) The following points system will be applied:
 - i. Win 1 point
 - ii. Draw $\frac{1}{2}$ point
 - iii. Lose 0 point

- (b) The following tie breaker system shall be applied will be applied (in listed order) to determine the winner:
 - i. Game Point.
 - ii. Match Point.
 - iii. Direct Encounter.
 - iv. Sonneborn-Berger.
 - v. Play off. (Each team select a representative. White with 6 minutes must win Black with 5 minutes. Colours decided through draw lots arranged by arbiter.)

5. ATTIRE

The participants must wear the attire provided by their respective universities.

6. PROTEST OR APPEAL AGAINST RESULTS

- (a) Any protest must be submitted to the Referee in writing by the Team Manager together with a deposit of **USD75** and within 30 minutes after the end of the match.

- (b) If the protest is rejected, the deposit shall be forfeited. If the protest is upheld, the deposit shall be returned.
